RC Sproul- to know the Son or Father through 'gnosis' intimate knowledge is more than knowing about Him as in creation. Because Christ reveals the Father to us, specifically thru His holy character

3- Why do YOU rejoice? - ?

1 Peter 1:1-12 - born again, you rejoice even in trials

having not seen Him, you believe in Him, rejoicing with joy inexpressible

Philippians 4:1-9 - rejoice in the Lord always

JC Ryle- Christ is Head of all things, King of kings. He is distinct from the Father yet entirely one with Him. He is the mighty revealer of the God who pardons iniquity and sinners for His Son's sake. With such a Savior we begin boldly and press on hopefully, because Christ is over all, and will not fail anyone who trusts in Him.
