Luke 11:3 when you pray, say, “Father, Give us each day our daily bread.”

Matt 6:11 pray then like this, “Our Father in heaven, Give us this day our daily bread.”

Matt 6:11 - our petition

Gen 1,9 - given for food

Gen 8:22 - promised

Psalms 104 - all look to You

Acts 14:17, 17:24 - food

James 1:17 - every gift

1 Tim 4:3-4 - received

In 'give us each day our daily bread' Jesus teaches us to acknowledge our dependence on the providence of God to sustain us day to day. We should live in daily dependence on the provision that God gives. -RC Sproul

2- Why pray to God, “our daily bread”? - providence

Exodus 16, Psalm 105-107

Luke 11:3 - each day our

Matt 6:24-34 - don't be anxious

Phil 4:4-13 - but in everything

Gen 3:19 - sweat of your brow

2 Thss 3:6-16 - won't work won't eat

1 Tim 5:3-16 - do be ambitious

3- What if YOU pray this prayer? -& what if you don't?

Prov 30:8-9 - food that is needful

Deut 8:3 - live by God's every word

John 6:25-34 - food that endures

John 6:35-59 - I AM the bread of life

2 Cor 9:6-15 - all grace abound to you

In the morning, it is a prayer for the needs of the day. In the evening, it is a prayer for the needs of the next day. But it also requests that God meet our needs with the bread of the ultimate tomorrow, the bread of eternity. -RK Hughes
