**Luke 12:31** “seek His kingdom, and these things will be added to you”

**Luke 12:32** “fear not, little flock, for it is the Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom”

**Luke 12:33** “sell your possessions, and give to the needy... with a treasure in the heavens”

**Luke 12:34** “for where your treasure is, there will be your heart also”

**1- How do you MEASURE a life?** - seeking

Luke 12:29 - don't seek earthly

Luke 12:30 - do seek eternal

*Instead of striving after worldly treasures as if they were an end in themselves, use these treasures as a means to strive for the kingdom of God. -J McDurmon*

**2- What is the PLEASURE of life?** - giving

Luke 12:31 - fear not, little flock

Luke 12:32 - give you the kingdom

*Jesus' promise is not about luxuries but essentials. To imagine we have luxuries because we have sought God's kingdom is a wicked delusion. One's commitment to the kingdom is the key to a life liberated from worry and anxiety. -RK Hughes*

**3- What are the true TREASURES?** - eternal

Luke 12:33 - cast off your stuff

Luke 12:34 - lay up in heaven

*Give freely, without anxiety, in light of God's provision of all your needs. We are storing up treasure as we seek after His kingdom. Put your heart and your treasure with the kingdom of God, and you will have nothing to fear. -RC Sproul*

**4- How then, shall YOU live?** - in Christ

Isaiah 35:1-10 - ransomed

Matt 6:19-34 - redeemed

1 Peter 1:1-25 - eternally

1 Thess 5:12-24 - rejoice

*The coming of Christ Jesus clarifies all that is real and valuable. Fear not, little flock, it is the Father's pleasure to give you His kingdom. Pleasures on earth are temporal, fleeting, and cannot be kept. Treasures in heaven are eternal, everlasting, and cannot be lost. True joy is in valuing what Jesus values, and investing in His treasures. Stop pursuing worldly things; start laying up real treasures, in heaven. Depending on Him.*


