

LEARNING WITH LUKE 20:9-20 "TIME FOR THE SON" P. 1045 PEW BIBLE

Luke 20:13-17 - I will send My beloved Son; perhaps they will respect Him. But the tenants threw Him out of the vineyard and killed Him. Then the owner of the vineyard will come and destroy those tenants and give the vineyard to others. "The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." Mark 12:1-12

Matthew 21:33-46 - *the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people producing its fruits.*

1- GOD'S VINEYARD - His people

2- GOD'S CORNERSTONE - Lord Jesus Christ
