

LEARNING WITH LUKE 22:14-20 "TIME TO RECEIVE" P. 1048 PEW BIBLE

Luke 22:19-20 - And He took bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me." And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood."

All of His life, the significance of Passover was inscribed on the soul of our Lord Jesus. Every Passover had pointed to this one. They all pointed to the cross, and the real and final Exodus that would come through the shed blood of the Lamb of God. He would lead His people out of bondage to Satan and sin, by the sacrifice of Himself. -SB Ferguson

1- THE SUPPER - Passover

Luke 22:14-18 - remembrance
Luke 2:41 - annually
Heb 12:2 - for the joy
Exodus 12:1-51 - memorial
Exodus 19:3-8 - covenant
Isaiah 25:6-9 - Messiah
Revelation 19:6-9 - Lamb
Luke 13:29, 14:15 - kingdom

*God instituted Passover saying, Don't ever forget this night, when death passed over My people who were marked by the blood of the lamb. Christ instituted the Lord's Supper saying, Don't ever forget My death for sinners. -RC Sproul
He looks to God's redemptive works in the past, the present and the future, with a commemorative meal of salvation.*

2- THE BREAD - matzah

Luke 22:19 - unleavened
Deut 16:1-8 - unleavened
1Pet 2:24, Isa 53:5 - His body

The bread the believer eats at the Lord's Table, reminds of Christ's body given to death on the cross for sins. The wine reminds the believer of Christ's blood shed to make atonement for the transgressions of the world. -JC Ryle

3- THE CUP - wine

Luke 22:20 - blood
John 6:35-71 - life
1Pet 1:18-21, Isa 53:12 - His blood

The elements are lively emblems, a visible sermon, appealing to our senses, teaching that Christ's death is the life of your soul. He who comes without faith cannot receive God's blessing. Empty he comes and empty he goes. -JC Ryle

4- THE COVENANT - new

Ex 24:1-8 - ratified by blood
Heb 9:11-28 - once for all, in Christ
Jer 31:31-34, Deut 30:6, Eze 26:22-27, 2Cor 3:1-4:6 - Holy Spirit

The old covenant launched on a sea of blood to emphasize the seriousness of sin, and to teach that the payment for sin is death. In the new covenant, salvation rests on the infinite ocean of divine blood 'poured out for you' -RK Hughes

5- THE COMMUNION - koinonia

Psalms 113-118, 136 - Hallel
1Cor 5:7-8 - our Passover Lamb
1Cor 10:16-17 - union in Christ
1Cor 11:17-34 - remember

This Christmas Communion, receive all God's promises through Christ Jesus our Lord & Savior, who has humbly come, who is now present with and within us, and who is coming again in power and great glory forever and ever.
