Luke 22:31-38 - “Satan demanded to have you, that he might sift you like wheat, but I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail” ... “But now let the one who has a moneybag take it, and likewise a knapsack. And let the one who has no sword sell his cloak and buy one. For I tell you the Scripture must be fulfilled in Me”

**1- PETER'S BRAVADO - are you over-confident?**

John 13:31-38 - more context  
Luke 22:31-33 - Satan sifting  
Luke 4:1-13 - tempted by Satan  
Job 1:6-12, 2:1-6 - permission  
Amos 9:9, Eph 4:27 - opportunity  
Prov 16:18, 1 Cor 10:11-13 - heed  
John 10:10-15, 26-30, 2 Tim 2:8-15

*Let us be on our guard against the devil's devices. He is a murderer and liar who appears as an angel of light and stirs up division. We must watch and pray and put on the whole armor of God, and we must resist him. -JC Ryle*

**2- JESUS PROPHECIES - what will actually happen**

Luke 22:33-34 - you will deny  
Jn 13:36-28, Mt 26:30-35, Mk 14:26-31  
Luke 22:54-62, Acts 12:5-6, John 21:15-19  
1 Peter 1:3-21, 2 Peter 1:3-11 - cleansed  
2 Cor 1:2-11 - comfort those in affliction

*Judas was diabolical from the beginning, never a converted man. But Peter was truly born again. Believers can be harassed, oppressed, tormented, tempted, and accused by Satan and his demons. Peter will even deny Jesus. But Peter does not lose his salvation, because Christ Himself preserves all those who belong to Him. -RC Sproul*

John 14:27-31 - troubled  
John 15:18-27 - persecute  
John 16:1-3, 31-33 - peace  
John 17:1-26 - persevere  
Isa 53:12, Luke 23:32-33  
Zech 13:7, Mt 26:56, Mk 14:50

*Jesus was numbered with the transgressors as He was hung on a cross between two outlaws. We transgressors can find saving identification in Him, because He not only identified with our sin, He atoned for our sin. -RK Hughes*

*The hope of the dull, self-centered, presumptuous, weak disciples in the upper room is our hope as well. Jesus Christ the Lord is originator and mediator of the new covenant. He does it all, and He is the hope for everyone! -RK Hughes*
