

LEARNING WITH LUKE 22:63-71 “TIME FOR TRIAL” P. 1049 PEW BIBLE

Luke 22:63-71 - “If you are the Christ, tell us.” But He said to them, “if I tell you, you will not believe, and if I ask you, you will not answer. But from now on the Son of Man will be seated at the right hand of the power of God.” So they all said, “Are you the Son of God then?” And He said to them, “You say that I am.”

Temple guards demean Jesus as God's prophet, and Roman soldiers deride Him as God's king. The Sanhedrin mocks Him as God's priest, whose task is to make a way for sinners into the presence of God. Israel's High Priest charges Him with blasphemy so He will be put to death, as though He were a priest's sacrificial victim. -SB Ferguson

1- WHO STRUCK YOU ? - (Annas) - mocking & beating

John 18:12-24 - *bound*

2- HAVE YOU NO ANSWER ? - (Caiaphas) - false witnesses

Mark 14:53-60 - *not agree*
John 2:13-21 - *this temple*
Luke 20:1-8 - *confounded*

In this present time, believers take part in their Master's suffering and with Him are weak, mocked, despised, and disbelieved. Hereafter we shall share in His glory and with Him be strong, sitting at the right hand of God. -JC Ryle

3- ARE YOU THE CHRIST ? - (Sanhedrin) - blasphemy

Luke 22:69 - *Son of Man*
Daniel 7:13-14 - *dominion*
Psalm 110:1-7 - *power*
Luke 22:70 - *Son of God*
Luke 9:18-45 - *My Son*
Luke 3:21-22, 4:3-9 - *Son*
John 1:1-18 - *the only God*
Acts 2:22-36 - *raised up*
Matt 26:63-68 - *judgment*
Mark 14:61-65, 15:1 - *council*

Jesus issues a word of warning. They may think they hold the power of life and death over Him. But all too soon, they will stand before the Son of Man, and be judged. In condemning Jesus, they condemn themselves. -SB Ferguson

4- WHAT IS YOUR VERDICT ? - who do YOU say that I am?

1 Peter 2:19-25 - *suffering*
1 Peter 3:13-18 - *witness*
Luke 9:23-27 - *ashamed*

Jesus demonstrated incredible mastery at His religious trial, declaring that He is the long-awaited Christ, Messiah, deliverer, and the glorious Son of Man, ruler of all, and the divine Son of God, to make atonement for sin. -RK Hughes
